### **Community Safety Street Lighting Application**

Since 2010, Derbyshire County Council's Community Safety Unit has worked in partnership with Derbyshire County Council's Environmental Services and the District and Borough Councils to improve street lighting in areas where there are higher levels of crime, anti-social behaviour and fear of crime, and where it is considered that additional street lighting will have a positive impact on those issues.

During the 5 years since this initiative started, there have been 41 sites improved. We have received over 250 enquiries; some of which did not meet the criteria and some cases which were resolved by multi agency working without the need for additional street lights.

We have some funding for 2015/16 and you are invited to submit an application for additional or improved street lighting in areas in your community, where there are higher levels of crime, anti-social behaviour and fear of crime, and where it is considered that additional street lighting will have a positive impact on crime, anti-social behaviour and fear of crime.

We will need you to fill out an application form where you will be able to specify your reasons for requesting the additional or improved lighting. Any details of crime or anti-social behaviour should be recorded here so that we are able to assess the scheme accordingly.

The Community Safety Street Lighting Grant will fund lighting schemes where Derbyshire County Council has ownership of the land where additional or improved street lighting is requested e.g. highways.


Consideration may be given to applications that are not on Derbyshire County Council maintained highway, but owned by the local Borough, District, or Parish Council. However, these applications will only be progressed upon receipt of that local authority's permission and agreement that they would accept future energy and maintenance liabilities. We are not able to consider requests that are on private property.
