### **Purpose for which any Grant will be used?**

To support the holding a one day Duffield Arts Festival in October 2015. The purpose will be to provide a unique enjoyable event, in addition to building a legacy by starting a structured approach to income generation for an annual event starting summer 2016. The majority of events will be free of charge.

The specific expenditure will be for the following:

Printed marketing material (for delivery to every Duffield resident) (£220)  
Directional signage (£210)  
Venue hire costs (part) (£140)  
Commissioning of four performers (£150)  
Transport of Steps for the Future (disabled dance group charity) members (£50)  
General out of pocket expenses for volunteers (£60)

£830 would be required.

**What is your annual committed expenditure?.**

For the October Arts Festival in the region of £2000.

For the annual Summer Arts Festival it is estimated to be in the region of £4000 to £4500. However this will be secured through income generation.

**Explain the benefits of your Organisation to the residents of Duffield**

The objective will be to produce events that will involve the village community and cater for all villagers ensuing that the majority will appeal to all the family. Working in collaboration with many partners, a programme will be delivered consisting of a broad range of arts, which will encourage a greater awareness of and participation and outstanding and engaging arts across different media and art forms. The intention is to make it a great fun event that will really involve the village.

Specifically the benefits are as follows:

Socially - This will provide another event, where the community are brought together along with giving them the opportunity for active participation. All parts of our community, including the elderly and the young will have opportunity to come together as a collective to enjoy and take part in some unique events.

Culturally - They will be new cultural experiences for Duffield as a community.

Economically - With considerably increased footfall in the village, local business will benefit. Local artists will be supported in showcasing their work.

Sustainability - The event will provide opportunities for a legacy, for the community and the council.

Partnerships - New partnerships will be formed helping create an increasingly cohesive community.

Measurement of success- there will be clear measures in place to determine the success of event including attendance, participation, comments and web hits.

**What proportion of the membership of your Organisation is drawn from the Parish of Duffield?**

95%. Of note all committee members with the exception of the secretary are from Duffield.
